TAHOE. The Vortec 5.3L V8 engine, standard in LS 4x4 models and all LT and LTZ models, features Active Fuel Management technology that helps balance 320 hp with better fuel economy than any competitor.¹ Standard in Tahoe LS 2WD models, a Vortec 4.8L V8 engine generates 295 horsepower and 305 lb.-ft. of torque. New for 2009, a Vortec 6.2L V8 engine² is available for Tahoe LTZ models and kicks out a prodigious 395 horsepower and 417 lb.-ft. of torque.



HYBRID

TAHOE HYBRID. A 6.0L V8 engine provides Tahoe Hybrid (at participating dealers only) with the power you expect from a Chevy Truck – 332 horses and 367 lb.-ft. of torque. At the same time it helps 2WD models offer an EPA estimated MPG 21 city, 22 highway, and 4x4 models offer an MPG 20 city, 20 highway.

SUBURBAN. In 2WD and 4x4 half-ton models, the Vortec 5.3L V8 engine generates 310 hp, with 2WD models offering an EPA estimated MPG 14 city, 20 hwy. The available Vortec 6.0L V8 in 2LT³ and LTZ half-ton models creates 366 horsepower and 376 lb.-ft. of torque. The Vortec 6.0L V8 standard in three-quarter-ton models delivers 352 horsepower and 382 lb.-ft. of torque.

AVALANCHE. In 2WD and 4x4 models, the Vortec 5.3L V8 engine produces 310 horses, with 2WD models offering an EPA estimated MPG 14 city, 20 highway. The Vortec 6.0L V8 engine available in 2LT³ and LTZ models delivers 366 horsepower and 376 lb.-ft. of torque.

TAHOE HYBRID PROPULSION SYSTEM



Here's a brief overview of how the two-mode hybrid propulsion system works:

- Mode 1 – In the first mode, at low speeds and with light loads, the vehicle can operate three ways: electric power, engine power or in any combination of electric and engine power. When operating on electric power, with no engine power needed, you receive all the benefits of a full hybrid system.
- Mode 2 – The second mode is used primarily at highway speeds. It provides electric assist in addition to four-cylinder or full eight-cylinder power when driving conditions demand it, such as trailer towing and climbing steep grades.



The addition of a second mode to the drive system reduces the need for large electric motors, which are used in today's single-mode systems. Tahoe Hybrid employs two smaller motors that are lighter and efficiently packaged within the space of its automatic transmission. Shifts between the two modes are synchronous, which means no engine speed changes are necessary for the mode shift to occur. This results in very smooth acceleration for Tahoe Hybrid.

VORTEC 5.3L V8 FLEXFUEL ENGINE



BIOFUELS

Standard in Tahoe⁵, Suburban half-ton and Avalanche 4x4 models and available in those same vehicles for 2WD models, this engine operates on either regular unleaded gasoline; E85 – a blend of 85% ethanol and 15% gasoline; or any combination of both. Because ethanol is made from primarily organic, domestic resources, E85 is a mostly renewable fuel that can help reduce our dependence on petroleum.

- E85 is a cleaner-burning fuel source, which helps reduce smog-forming emissions.
- Plus, E85 generally has a higher octane rating than regular unleaded gasoline, which can result in slightly higher horsepower and torque levels. In fact, when running on E85, the Vortec 5.3L V8 FlexFuel engine generates 326 horsepower and 350 lb.-ft. of torque.
- Chevy has over 2 million E85-capable FlexFuel vehicles on the road today.

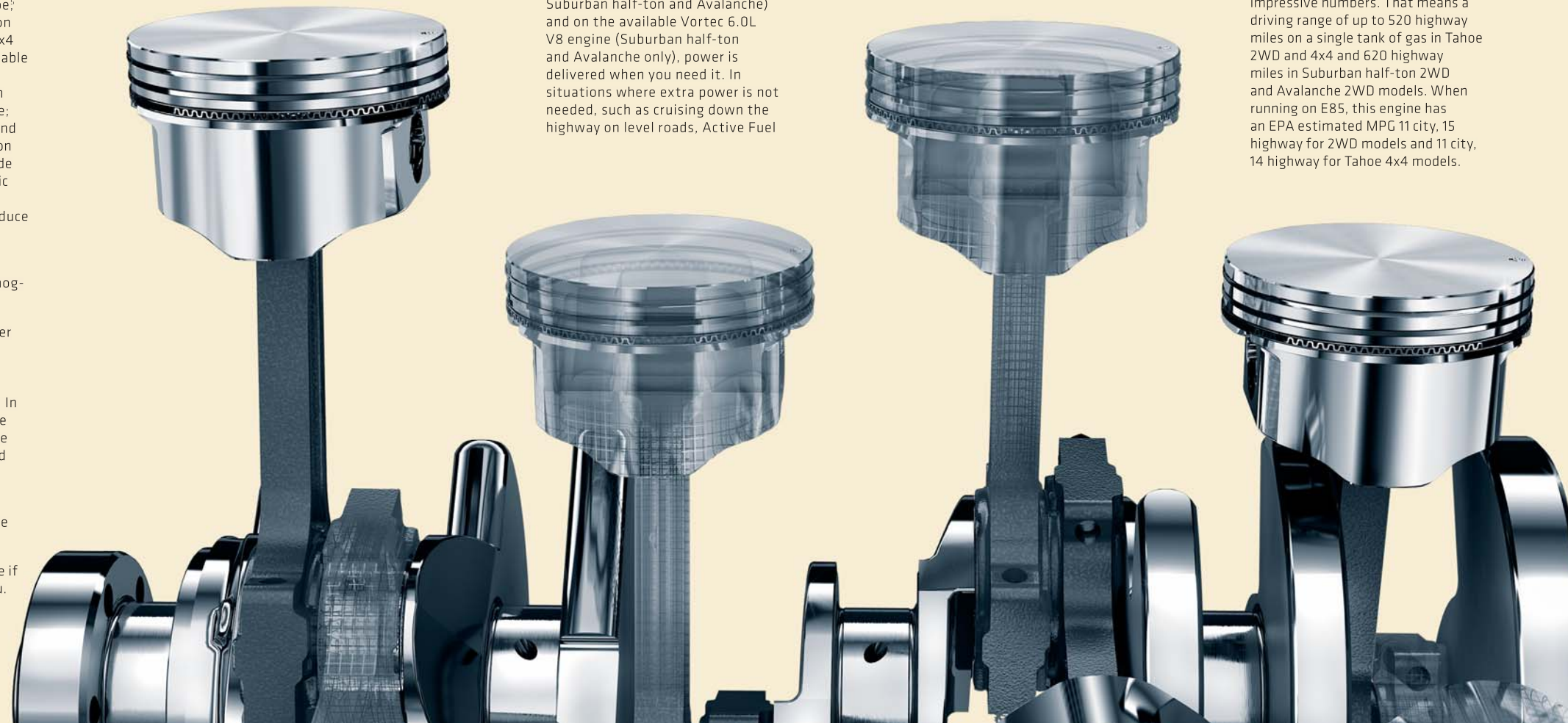
FUEL EFFICIENCY

With Active Fuel Management technology from GM on the available Vortec 5.3L V8 engine (Tahoe, Suburban half-ton and Avalanche) and on the available Vortec 6.0L V8 engine (Suburban half-ton and Avalanche only), power is delivered when you need it. In situations where extra power is not needed, such as cruising down the highway on level roads, Active Fuel

Management deactivates four of the eight cylinders with seamless precision. When load demands increase, such as when the vehicle accelerates or travels uphill, cylinders are reactivated to provide eight-cylinder operation.

Active Fuel Management technology helps Tahoe, Suburban half-ton and Avalanche models

equipped with the Vortec 5.3L V8 engine offer an EPA estimated MPG 14 city, 20 highway for 2WD models. Tahoe 4x4 offers those same impressive numbers. That means a driving range of up to 520 highway miles on a single tank of gas in Tahoe 2WD and 4x4 and 620 highway miles in Suburban half-ton 2WD and Avalanche 2WD models. When running on E85, this engine has an EPA estimated MPG 11 city, 15 highway for 2WD models and 11 city, 14 highway for Tahoe 4x4 models.



TRAILERING BASICS

NOTE: Towing a trailer involves all major vehicle systems of your Chevy Truck. Easy and safe trailering requires a properly equipped vehicle, additional trailering equipment and an appropriate trailer. It also requires loading both the vehicle and trailer properly, using safe driving techniques, meeting regional legal requirements, and following break-in and maintenance schedules. For more information, consult your Owner's Manual, speak to a trailering expert at your Chevrolet dealership or visit our web site at chevy.com. To help you better understand trailering, consider these trailering factors:

RGAWR AND GVWR: Addition of trailer hitch weight cannot cause vehicle weights to exceed Rear Gross Axle Weight Rating (RGAWR) or Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR). These ratings can be found on the certification label located on the driver door or doorframe.

GCWR: The Gross Combination Weight Rating is the total allowable weight of the completely loaded vehicle and trailer.

MAXIMUM TRAILER RATING: This rating is determined by subtracting the tow vehicle's weight (curb weight) from the GCWR. When a base vehicle (curb) weight is used, additional passenger, equipment and cargo weight reduce this rating.

NOTE: The safety steps described here are by no means the only precautions to be taken when trailering. See the Owner's Manual for your Chevy vehicle for additional guidelines and trailering tips.

TRAILERING CAUTION: If you don't use the correct equipment and drive properly, you can lose control of your vehicle when you pull a trailer. If the trailer is too heavy, your vehicle brakes may be less effective. You and your passengers could be seriously injured. Pull a trailer only after you have taken the following steps.

TRAILER BRAKES: If your trailer weighs more than 2,000 lbs. loaded, then it must have its own adequate brakes. Be sure to read and follow the instructions for the trailer brake controller so that it is installed, adjusted and maintained properly. ■ Don't tap into your vehicle's brake system.

HITCHES: It's important to have the correct hitch equipment. ■ If you'll be towing a trailer that, when loaded, will weigh more than 5,000 lbs., be sure to use a frame-mounted, weight-distributing hitch and sway control of the proper size. ■ If you have to make any holes in the body of your vehicle to install a trailer hitch, be sure to seal the holes if you ever remove the hitch. If they're not sealed, dirt, water and deadly carbon monoxide from the exhaust can get into your vehicle.
