LOCATION, LOCATION, LOCATION. When it comes to minivans, the prime real estate is the cargo area. How much will it hold?



With Voyager, you can take along everything you'll need: jet skis, dogs, plywood sheets, the neighborhood baseball team.

With the rear seats removed, Voyager stands ready and able with **142.9 cubic feet of cargo space.**

With the deluxe seven-passenger seating, Grand Voyager can carry a 4'x8' sheet of plywood with the rear seats folded down and the liftgate closed. There's also room to store 28 2x4s under the backseats.

For those who need even more, Grand Voyager versatility goes a stretch further. Inside and out, front to back and side to side, Grand Voyager delivers more room, versatility and comfort. It's 13.3 inches longer and 25.6 cubic feet larger in cargo volume than a standard Voyager. With its rear bench seats removed, **an enormous 168.5 cubic feet of cargo space** awaits you. And with a liftgate design that features easy, low-effort opening and closing, Voyager and Grand Voyager offer versatility at its very best.

VERSATILITY, CAPABILITY AND GENEROUS CARGO

ROOM are the in-demand vehicle priorities of today's active lifestyles.

These demands are aptly met by Voyager's **many seating configurations** (bottom), and rear seats that can be folded (on most seating packages) for increased cargo capability when it's not convenient to remove them. **Quad Command bucket seats*** provide a more personal seating area in the intermediate position. For maximum versatility, each bucket seat can recline or fold into a "table." Moving them is relatively easy as well, because they weigh less than 50 pounds each. **Easy Out Roller Seats®** (right) also make the conversion from rear seating to cargo-carrying an uncomplicated effort. Eight rollers guide the bench seat as it is unlatched, and molded tracks in the floor reduce resistance to rolling. The area behind the rear bench is made more accessible with a wide, tall liftgate.



Easy Out Roller Seats feature aircraft-style wheels on all bench seats that "click" down for moving or removing the seat. They "click" back up to lock the seat in place.

A 3.0-liter OHV SMPI V6* engine provides more low-end torque, while a **3.3-liter OHV SMPI V6 engine[†]** delivers all the power and torque needed for virtually any towing application. And it's equipped with **platinum-tipped spark plugs** that eliminate scheduled tune-ups for up to 100,000 miles.[‡] When coupled with the 3.3-liter V6, Voyager's four-speed electronic transaxle allows you to tow up to 2,000 pounds when properly equipped — and to do it with fuel efficiency. **Towing capability of 3,500 pounds** is available with Grand Voyager SE, when properly equipped with the optional Trailer Tow Prep Group.

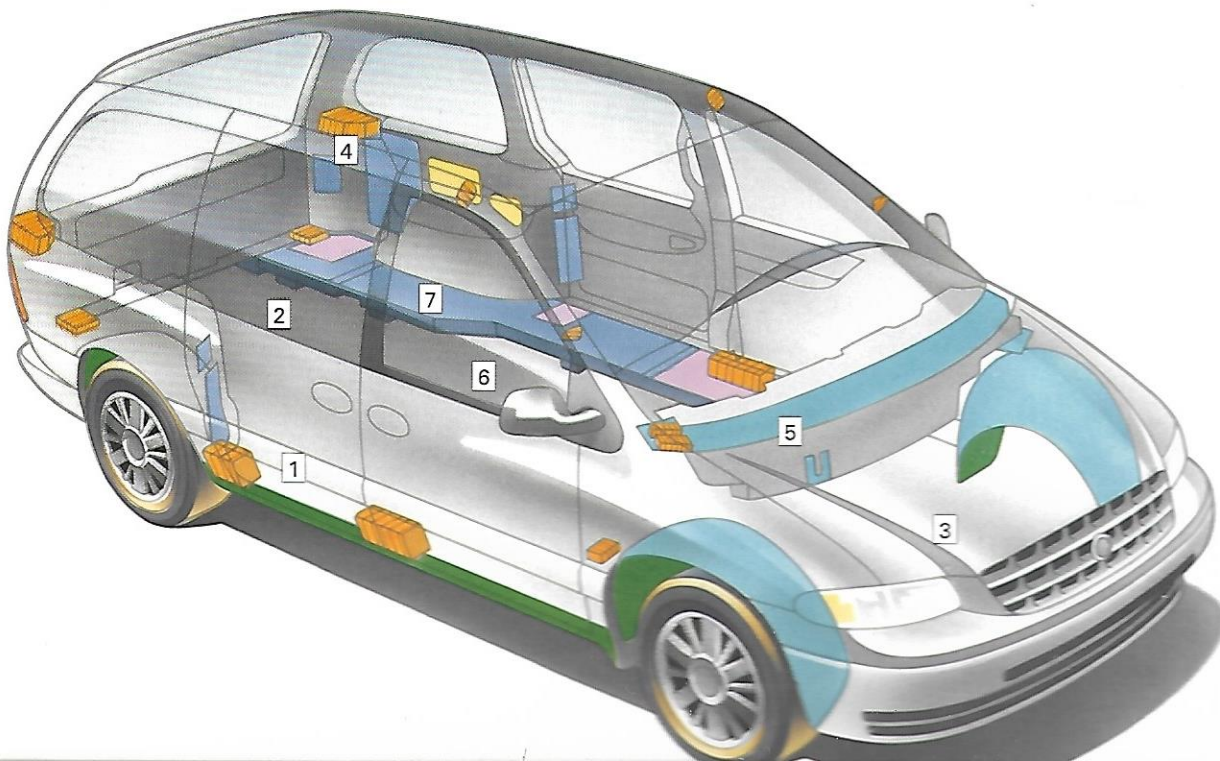

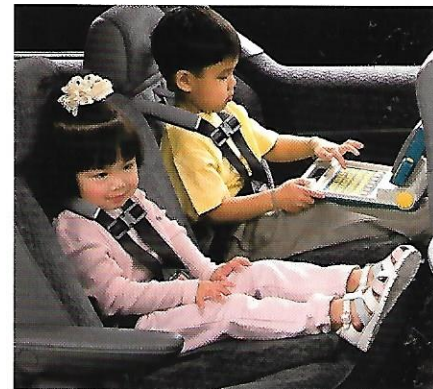

Next Generation driver and front-passenger air bags† are standard on every Voyager model. Optional **Multiposition Reclining Integrated Child Seats**‡ help keep your most precious cargo safer. Integrated Child Seats help keep children comfortable and securely seated. A single Integrated Child Seat is available with the optional Quad Command seating on Voyager SE and Grand Voyager SE. When the road becomes slippery, **four-wheel antilock brakes**§ will help you stop or allow you to steer through a skid. **High-strength steel side-guard door beams** in the driver, front-passenger and left and right sliding doors offer additional protection. And DaimlerChrysler endorses **Do The Buckle!**, a national consumer safety campaign designed to educate children — as well as all people who drive or ride in vehicles — on the importance of wearing seat belts. Voyager's **Comfort-Fit Seat Belt System**™ encourages usage with Super-Soft webbing, traveling seat belt buckles and height-adjustable shoulder belts on the front and mid-row outboard seats.

HELPING FAMILIES STAY SAFE has been part of our job from the beginning. For instance, Voyager's **Unibody construction** increases safety by minimizing body twist and giving it more "stiffness" to better handle the road. **Cab-forward design** puts the wheels toward the corners, providing for more road-handling stability and a large windshield area for a better and safer view of the road ahead. A patented **windshield de-icer** means that Voyager owners don't have to worry about frozen windshield wipers. The de-icer keeps wipers ready for cold-weather driving. With more minivan **safety firsts*** (see list at left) than any other manufacturer, Chrysler minivans have been ahead of the minivan pack since their introduction. As a new millennium dawns, they continue to lead the way.

2.4-LITER 16-VALVE DOHC ENGINE

The 2.4-liter DOHC balance-shaft four-cylinder engine produces excellent power and torque as well as substantial acceleration, with 150 horsepower at 5,200 rpm and 167 pound-feet of torque at 4,000 rpm.
