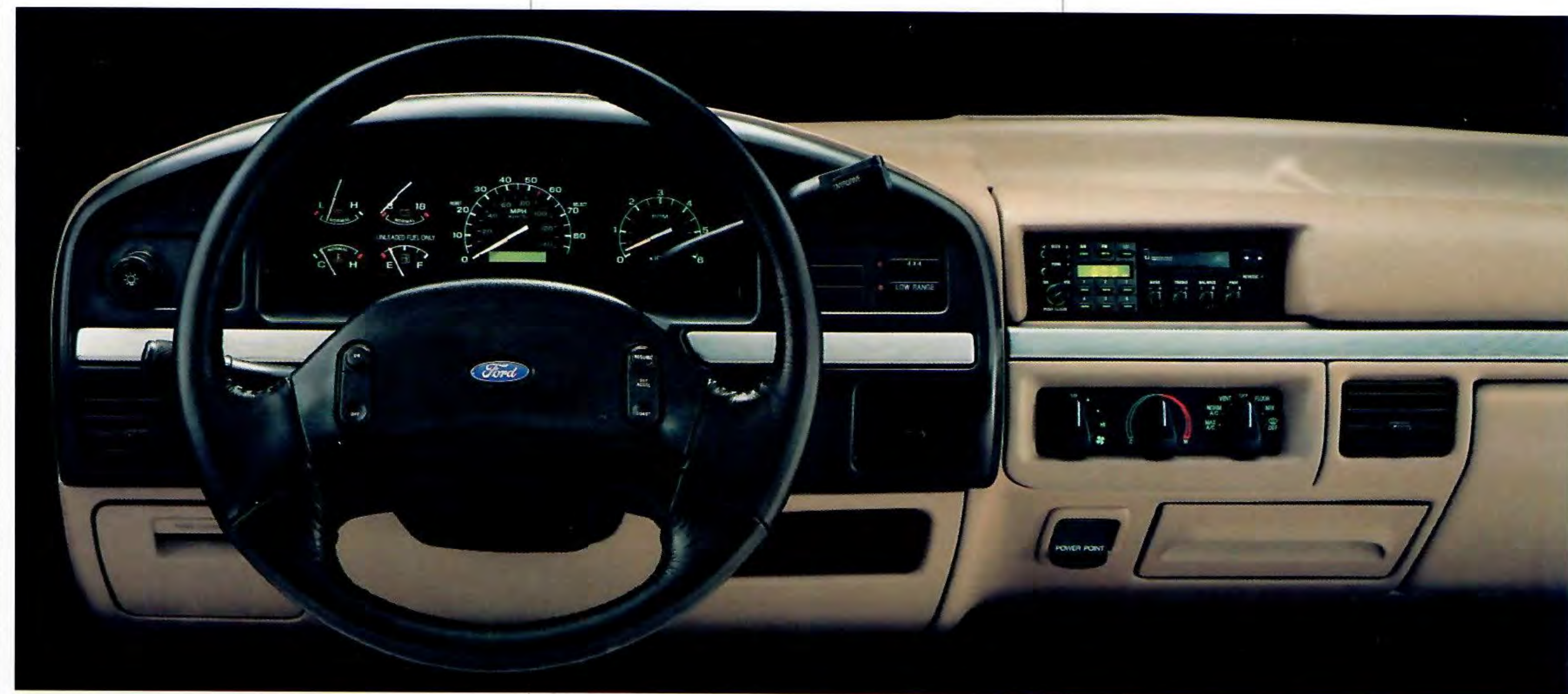

We also include an Eddie Bauer garment bag and duffel bag. Other equipment shown may be optional.

When we improved Ford Bronco for 1992, we had certain priorities in mind. We kept the items that have proven popular over the years, like pivoting vent windows; oil pressure and tem-



perature gauges; voltmeter; plus tachometer (XLT and Eddie Bauer).

But from the new instrument panel to the 4-speaker sound system, we gave it a more contemporary feel. After all, operating a Bronco should be fun.

Starting with the best seats in the house, we added optional Captain's Chairs with leather seating surface on the Eddie Bauer, XLT and "Nite" models. For an extra degree of riding comfort, the

Bronco's instrument panel has been redesigned for 1992, giving it a more contemporary appearance. Rotary air conditioning and heater controls, for example, fit the hand and are easily accessible.

Chairs include power lumbar supports.

A color-keyed, two-piece full-length headliner (XLT, Eddie Bauer and the "Nite" model) helps insulate you from exterior noises.

We've taken a look at how you live and added a Power Point electrical accessory outlet so you can plug in

convenience items like coffee pots or electric shavers when it's break time.

The Light/Convenience Group option now includes a console, between the bucket seat, with built-in cup-holder, coinholder and cassette holder plus ample room for personal items.

Finally, we've added three-point rear seat outboard safety restraints—something that won't go unnoticed. Or unappreciated. Little things still mean a lot.

Properly equipped, the 4.9L I-6 engine has a towing capacity (including passengers and cargo weight) as high as 5,100 lbs. The 5.0L V-8, 7,600 lbs. And the 5.8L V-8, 7,000 lbs.

All Bronco models, except the "Nite" truck, offer optional 15"x7.5" chrome-styled steel wheels and P265/75R15XL OWL All-Season tires (late availability). Custom is equipped with standard 15"x6.0" argent-styled steel wheels with sport wheel covers.

New for 1992, the Bronco Eddie Bauer interior includes optional Captain's Chairs with leather seating surfaces. Some equipment shown on these pages may be optional.



Everything needed to operate optional power windows, power door locks and exterior electric mirrors is conveniently located on the door trim panel.



The optional E4OD overdrive cancel switch is mounted on the shift lever for easy access. The switch is designed to prevent upshift to overdrive gear—particularly useful in hilly terrain to obtain third gear engine braking on downgrades.



4x4 Electric Touch Drive is an option in every Bronco trim level. Electric Touch Drive lets you shift "on the fly" from 2-wheel drive to 4-wheel drive high and back at normal road speeds—at the touch of a button.



Every Bronco comes with a full set of instruments to monitor important systems. A voltmeter. A tachometer (except Custom). Plus oil pressure and temperature gauges. We wouldn't have it any other way.

formidable powerteam. It's standard with Eddie Bauer and the "Nite" truck, optional on Custom and XLT. The optional Trailer Towing Package (with a 4.10 rear axle plus the E4OD electronic transmission) lets you tow up to 7,600 lbs. total capacity (including passengers and cargo weight).

Bronco is equipped with standard automatic locking hubs. Electric Touch Drive and manual locking hubs are optional. With the hubs engaged, all three systems allow you to shift "on the fly" from 2-wheel drive to 4-wheel drive high and back again at normal road speeds.

The E4OD electronically controlled transmission option was designed for improved fuel efficiency, performance and shift feel. A driver-activated overdrive cancel switch conveniently located on the shift lever, is designed to obtain third gear engine braking on downgrades.

BRONCO XLT "NITE" MODEL... A BOLD CHOICE FOR 1992.

In addition to Custom, XLT and Eddie Bauer, Ford offers the Bronco XLT "Nite" model for those of you who want something with a distinctly different appeal. The XLT "Nite" truck comes in Raven Black with blacked out trim; exterior "Nite" nomenclature; black

fiberglass roof and special bodyside tape stripes—your choice of Aegean Blue with Crystal Blue and Dark Charcoal interior or Azalea Pink with a Scarlet Red interior.

The interior includes black appliques and "Nite" nomenclature on the instrument panel plus color-keyed front and rear "Nite" floor mats.

Functional items include the 5.0L V-8 engine; forged aluminum deep-dish wheels; five P235/75Rx15XL OWL (outlined white letters) All-Season tires; Handling Package; Privacy™ glass plus outside swing-away spare tire carrier with black cover and "Nite" logo.



Wheel options include new 15" x 7.5" chrome-styled steel wheels on all models except the "Nite" truck. Forged aluminum deep-dish wheels, shown right with P265/75Rx15 OWL tires (late availability) are standard on Eddie Bauer and the "Nite" truck; optional on XLT and Custom.



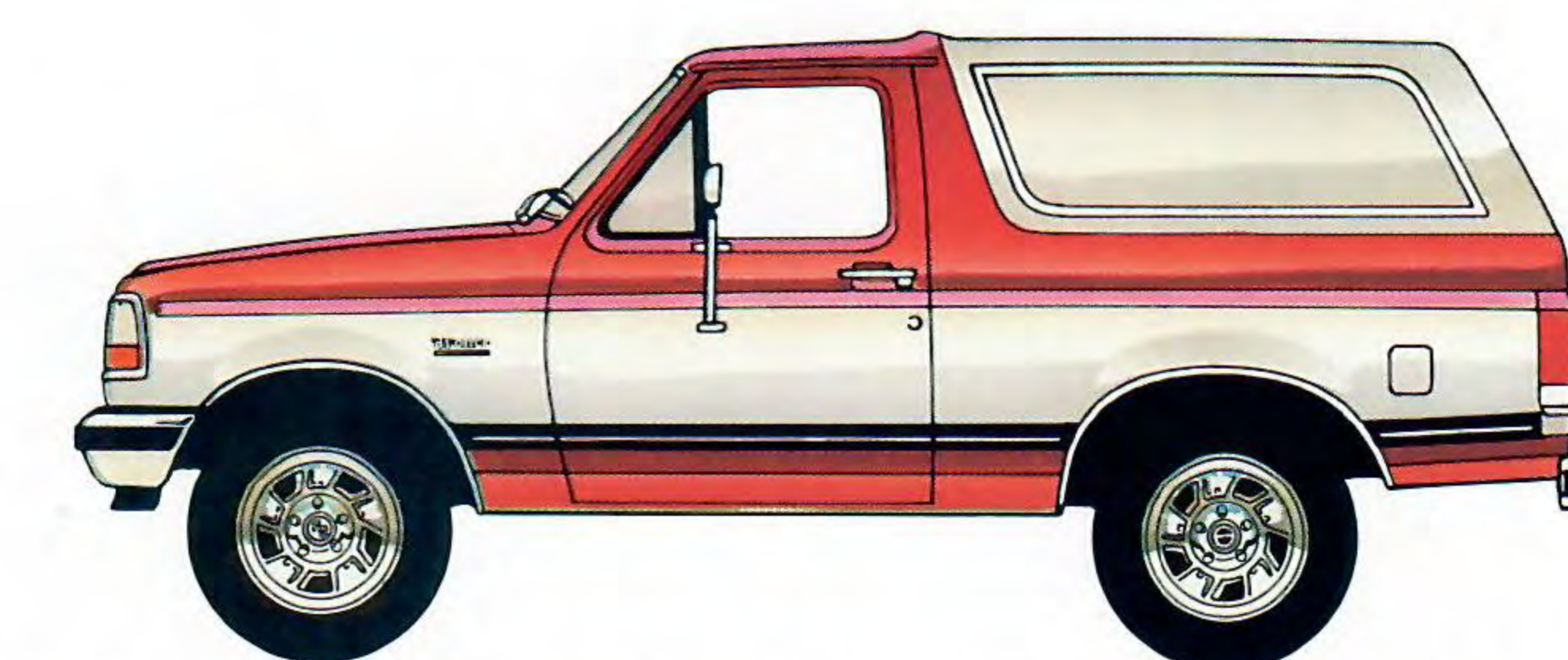

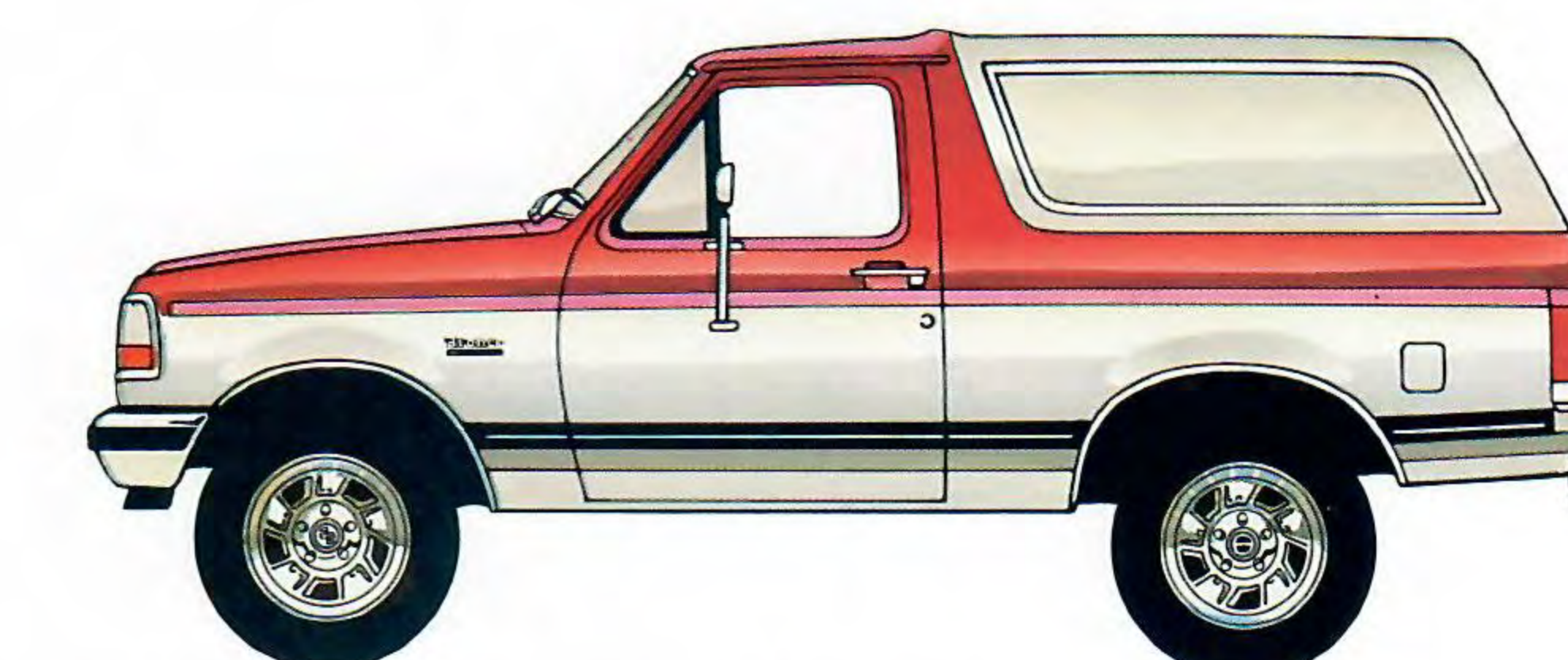
