The human voice is a powerful thing, especially when you consider what it can do with the LX Navigation System.⁵ Commands are more intuitive, so if you want to find the nearest gas station, you simply say, "Find the nearest gas station," and the navigation screen displays locations in your immediate vicinity. Once a destination is selected, up to three different routes are provided, along with audible and visual directions.

The voice-command system can even be used with compatible *Bluetooth*^{®8} cell phones. Say, "Call Jennifer at work" or "Let's call 310-555-1212," and moments later she's on the line.

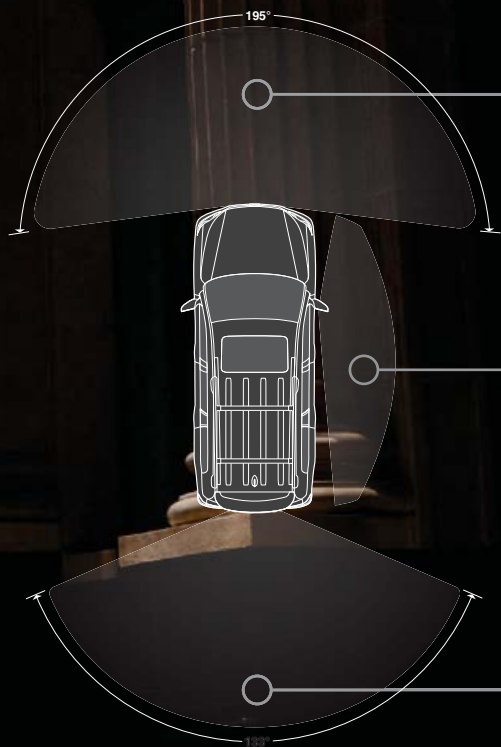

To help ensure the LX doesn't get too close to the vehicle traveling ahead, the available Dynamic Radar Cruise Control¹³ system adjusts the throttle and applies the brakes whenever necessary, helping to maintain a pre-set following distance. Once the lane appears clear, the LX resumes its pre-set cruising speed.

WHEN THE ROAD THROWS YOU A CURVE, MAKE SURE IT'S PROPERLY ILLUMINATED.

At speeds above 6 mph, the Dual-swivel Adaptive Front Lighting System (AFS) rotates the headlamps to help illuminate curves ahead. Depending on steering input, the headlamps can swivel up to 9 degrees in a left turn and up to 4 degrees in a right turn.

Daytime running lights help make the LX more visible to oncoming motorists. And automatic headlamp washers can be set to deploy when you use the front windshield wipers.

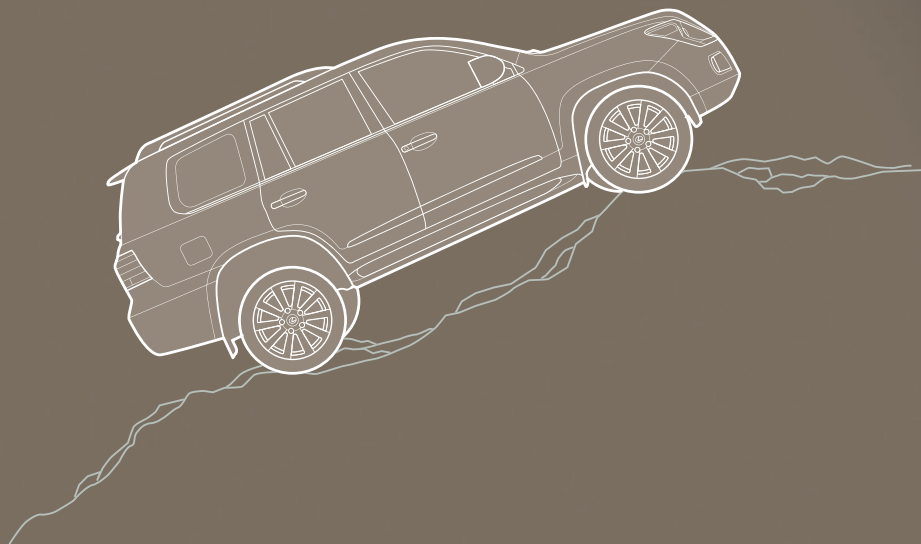

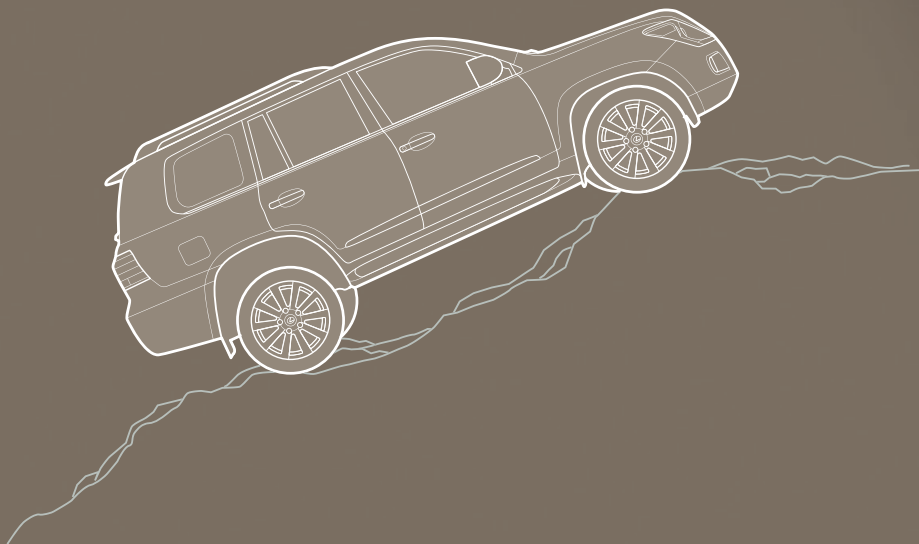

When you're faced with the seemingly impassable, the only thing better than a vehicle that can make it over obstacles is one that can make it easy. 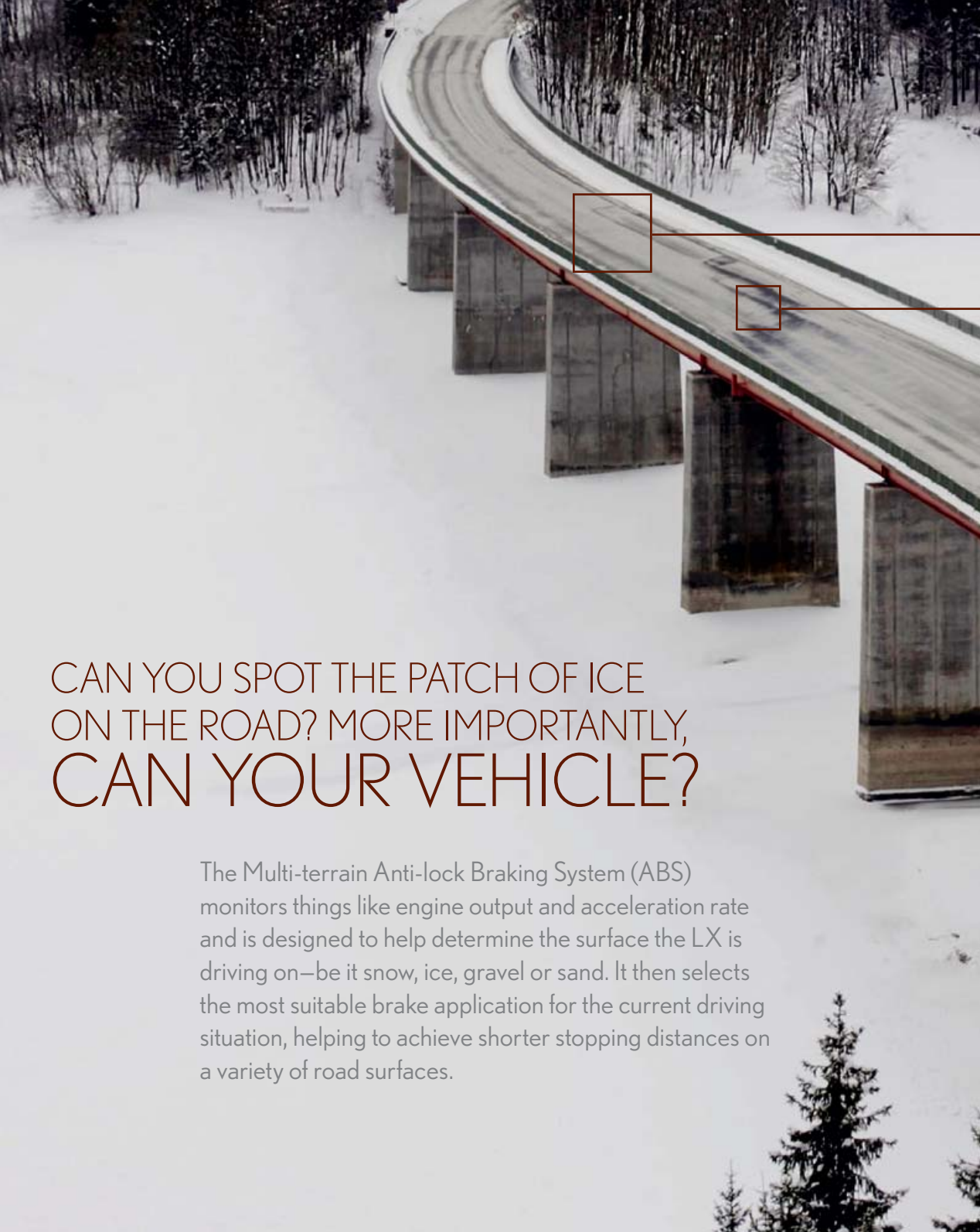

CAN YOU SPOT THE PATCH OF ICE ON THE ROAD? MORE IMPORTANTLY, CAN YOUR VEHICLE?

The Multi-terrain Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) monitors things like engine output and acceleration rate and is designed to help determine the surface the LX is driving on—be it snow, ice, gravel or sand. It then selects the most suitable brake application for the current driving situation, helping to achieve shorter stopping distances on a variety of road surfaces.



In sand or loose gravel, the system is designed to enable a certain degree of wheel slip so a “wedge” can form under the tires, helping to decrease stopping distances by up to 30%, while also maintaining steering control.



On ice or wet asphalt, the braking system is designed to sense a potential loss of traction and help reduce the likelihood of the wheels locking up.





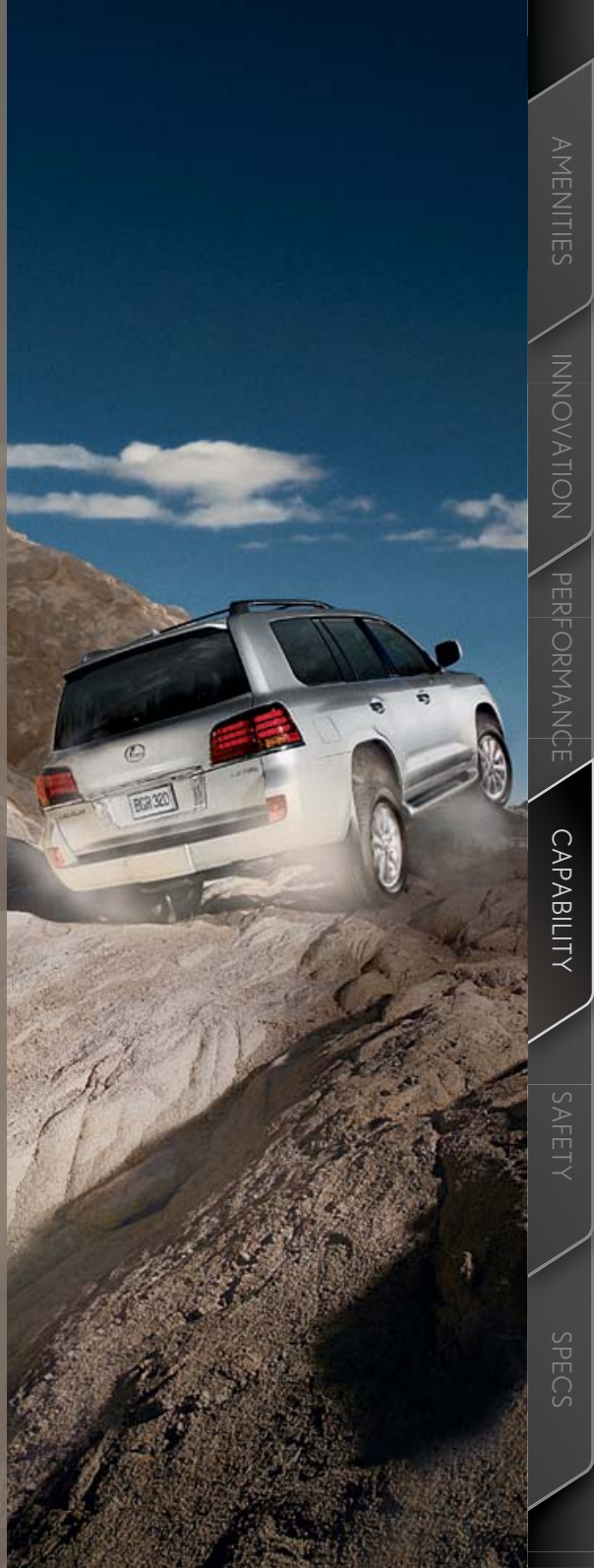

The LX is as capable off-road as it is on. A TORSEN[®] torque-sensing limited-slip center differential¹⁸ allows the LX to efficiently distribute engine power between the front and rear axles. Together, the full-time 4WD and Active Traction Control (A-TRAC) help reduce tire spin. Power is distributed to the wheels with traction, helping you drive in slick and off-road conditions without losing control. To help minimize frustration even further, the center differential can be locked for maximum traction in especially difficult off-road situations.

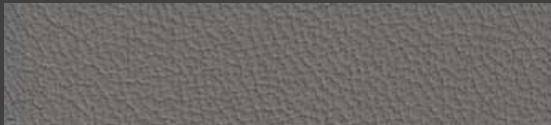

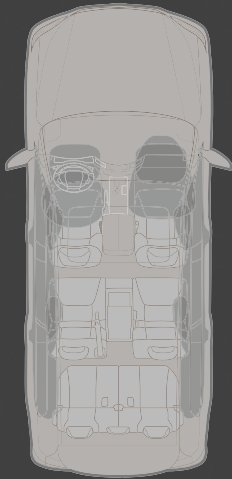

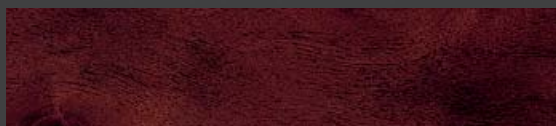
