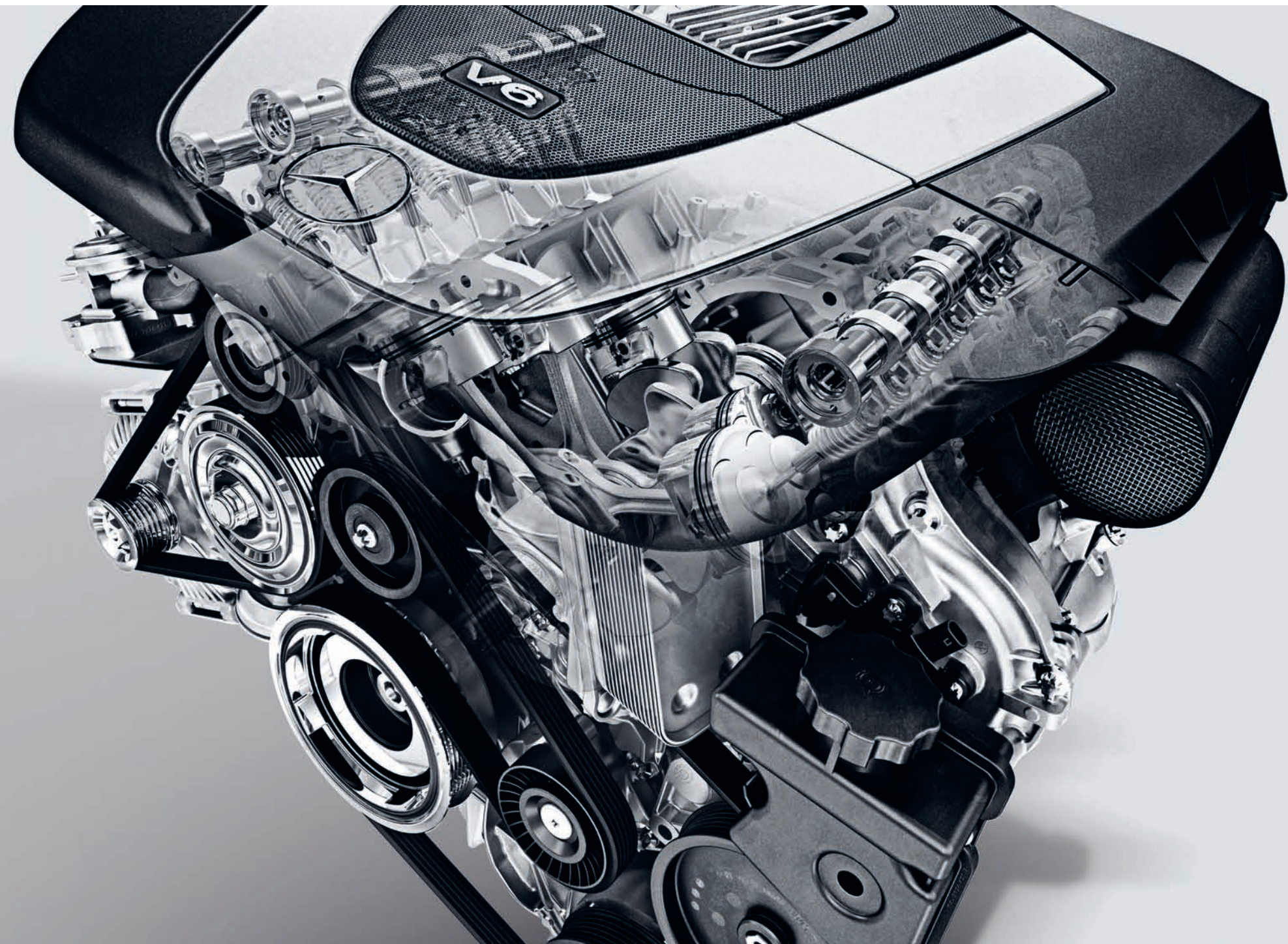

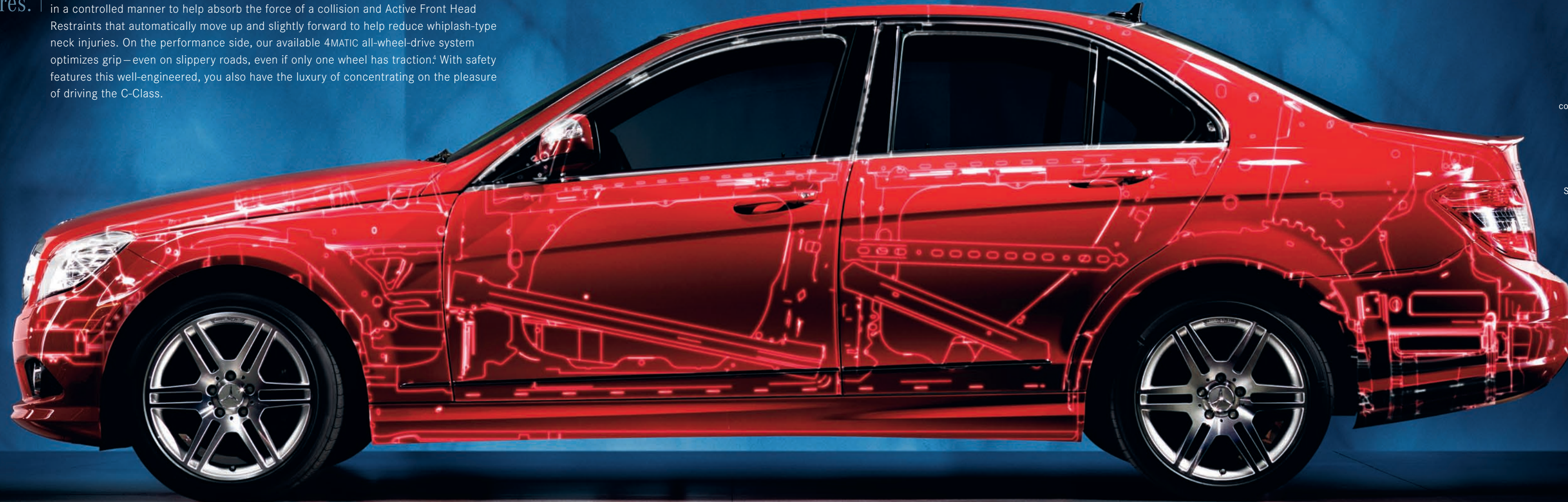

3.0-liter V-6 engine

Unleashing 228 horsepower and 221 lb-ft of torque, the 3.0-liter 24-valve dual overhead cam (DOHC) V-6 features variable intake and exhaust valve timing, with continually variable adjustment of all four cams for smooth idling and high-rpm punch. These features and more give this engine the flexibility to provide over 85% of peak torque from as low as 1,500 rpm while still supplying an exhilarating redline rush. How exhilarating? How does a 0-to-60 time of 7.1 seconds³ sound?

3.5-liter V-6 engine

The DOHC V-6 in the C 350 Sport Sedan is as efficient as it is exuberant. It commands 268 horsepower and 258 lb-ft of peak torque to keep your adrenaline flowing, moving from 0 to 60 mph in just 6.1 seconds.³ Continually variable timing on both the intake and exhaust valves coupled with a dual-stage intake manifold helps this powerplant deliver 100% of its peak torque from 2,400–5,000 rpm, ensuring immediate response to every throttle input.

AMG 6.3-liter V-8 engine

This aggressive naturally aspirated V-8 is mated to a 7-speed automatic transmission with AMG SPEEDSHIFT PLUS™ for ready access to that enormous strength. Feel a rush of euphoria as the engine develops a massive 451 horsepower and 443 lb-ft of torque to propel the C 63 AMG from 0 to 60 in just 4.3 seconds.³ And like all AMG engines, each is hand-built and signed by a single master technician.

6-speed, short-throw manual transmission

The 6-speed manual transmission in the C 300 Sport Sedan is designed to ensure an even sportier edge to your driving. Beneath the aluminum shift knob is a short-throw shifter with a precise direct-action rod-type linkage for quicker, more decisive gear changes.

7-speed automatic transmission

A wide range of closely spaced gears delivers the ideal gear ratio for virtually every driving condition. This driver-adaptive design comes equipped with Touch Shift and results in smoother cruising and immediate response for acceleration and passing, and even improved fuel efficiency on the highway. Clearly, our passion for advanced engineering isn't limited to our engines.

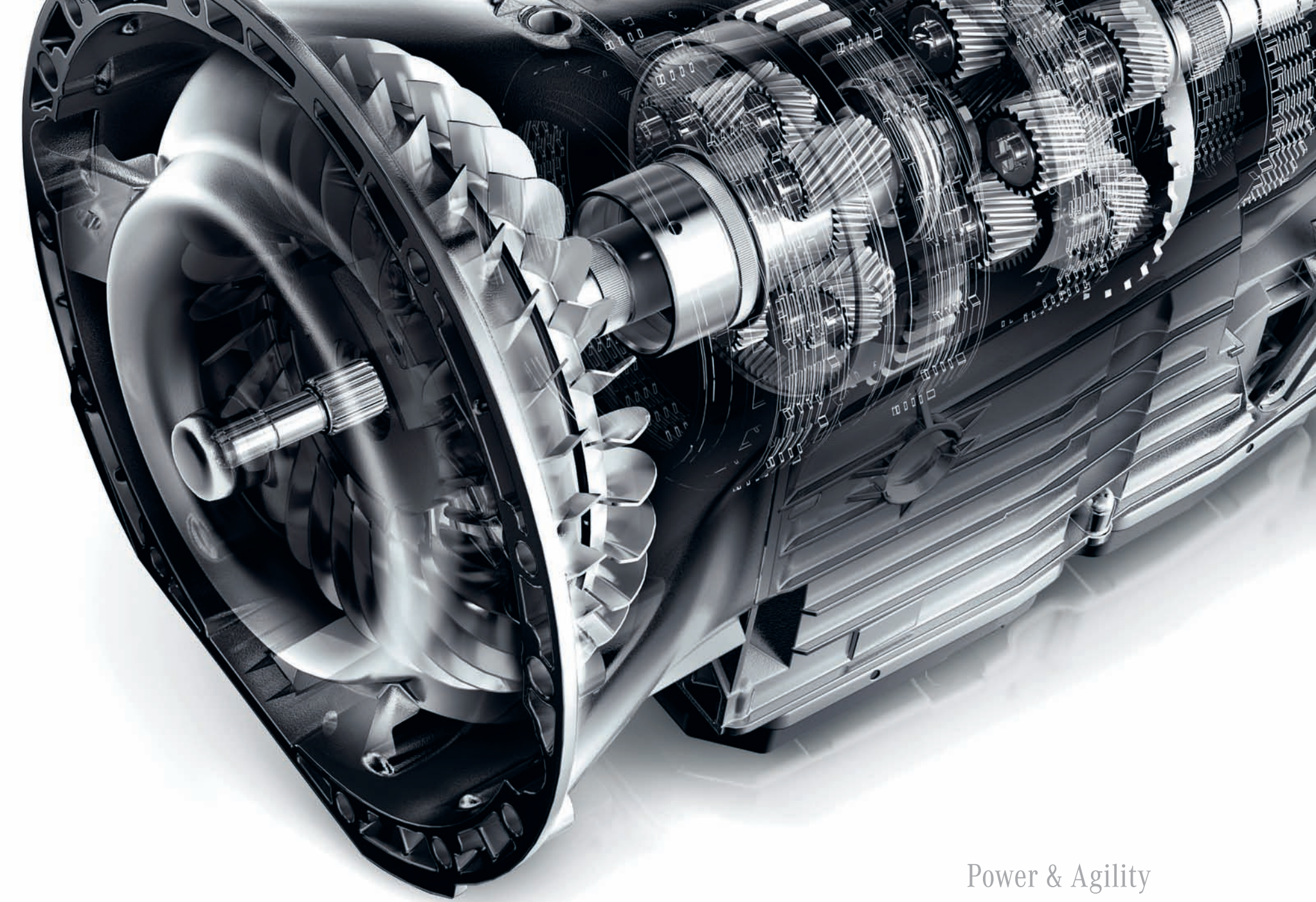

Engineered specifically for performance driving, the sport suspension features the AGILITY CONTROL breakthrough, with an amplitude-dependent damping system that adjusts dampers based on the surface of the road and the driver's current driving style for every wheel—individually, automatically—for high stability, superb ride comfort and maximum control.

4MATIC all-wheel drive

Available on C 300 Sport and Luxury Sedans, this permanent all-wheel-drive system provides optimum traction—even in slippery conditions—thanks to our advanced 4-wheel Electronic Traction System (4-ETS). 4-ETS can get you going even when only one wheel has grip. Sensors at each wheel monitor traction. If one or more wheels start to slip, 4-ETS brakes those wheels individually and ensures that power is delivered to the wheel or wheels with traction, keeping you cruising along.⁴

Advanced braking systems

The 4-wheel disc brakes in the C-Class offer our electronic 4-channel Antilock Braking System (ABS), an industry landmark pioneered by Mercedes-Benz in 1978. Take comfort in powerfully precise, nearly fade-free stopping control courtesy of large brake-disc dimensions—11.6" up front on C 300 Sedans and 12.7" on C 350 models, and 11.8" in back—and aluminum front brake calipers.² The systems are also enhanced with still more innovations, from Brake Drying that ensures maximum stopping power in inclement weather to Hill-Start Assist that helps prevent rolling back on an incline.

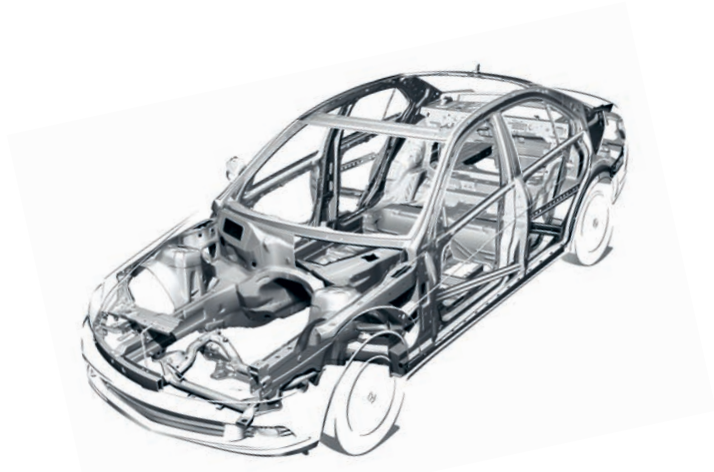

In addition to the power sunroof that comes standard on all C-Class models, there's also the Panorama Sunroof. This attractive option gives you and your passengers remarkably large views of the sky and gives the cabin a lighter, airier feel. And if any of you feel that there's a bit too much sun, simply click on the power sunshade. *Optional all C 300 and C 350 models. Not available C 63 AMG.*



Body structure

A range of precision safety elements work together to help protect you and your passengers in the event of a collision. Raising the bar for the industry, the body consists of about 50% High-Strength/Low-Alloy and 20% Ultra-High-Strength/Low-Alloy steel for an exceptionally rigid structure. Moreover, advanced front and rear crumple zones deform progressively to help absorb the energy of an impact. A front bulkhead also helps channel some of the forces of a frontal impact under, over and around the cabin.

Digital crash testing

Before the new C-Class experienced an actual passive-safety crash test, it underwent some 5,500 digital tests on our supercomputers. For the sake of comparison, crash simulation models in 1989 were based on 26,000 elements. In sharp contrast, the new C-Class ensured far greater accuracy by incorporating 1.9 million.

Electronic Stability Program (ESP®)

This advance continually monitors your vehicle's motion to help keep you going in your intended direction. If it detects wheelspin, severe understeer (plowing) or oversteer (fishtailing), ESP can brake individual wheels and reduce engine power to help bring the vehicle under control.⁴ Mercedes-Benz pioneered this safety landmark in 1995 and has continued to refine its exacting performance ever since.

Antilock Braking System (ABS)

ABS senses impending wheel lockup under heavy braking and pumps the front brakes individually or the rear brakes together. This intelligent system can pump the brakes as needed up to 30 times per second to prevent lockup and preserve steering ability.²

Brake Assist (BAS)

Research shows that drivers seldom apply the brakes hard enough, soon enough in emergency situations. BAS monitors pedal application speed to sense emergency braking and, in such cases, can deliver maximum stopping power, thereby helping to reduce overall stopping distances.²



Side-impact protection

Reinforced doors, side sills and floorpan are part of an integrated safety design that also includes high-strength seat structures and front-seat side-impact and pelvic air bags. All of these systems work together to help protect occupants during side impacts.

Innovative seat-belt technology

Equipped with Emergency Tensioning Devices (ETDs) and belt force limiters,² seat belts are arguably our most important passive safety feature. If a collision exceeds a preset threshold, the ETDs instantly remove slack from the seat belts. Belt force limiters allow a slight amount of give in the seat belts and reduce the peak seat-belt forces on the occupant.

Tire Pressure Monitoring System

The Tire Pressure Monitoring System will automatically detect a substantial loss of tire pressure in any wheel and alert the driver via a warning message.

Active Front Head Restraints

In the case of a rear impact exceeding a preset threshold, the Active Front Head Restraints move forward and slightly upward, reducing the distance between the head restraint and the front-seat occupants' heads. This action helps limit the rearward travel of their heads, thus reducing the possibility or severity of whiplash-type neck injuries.

Protection



Integrated Restraint System

The C-Class features an 8-way-protection, 6-air-bag system. It includes dual-stage front air bags (adaptive for the passenger side), front-seat side-impact air bags and full-length Window Curtain Air Bags. The Window Curtain Air Bags deploy along the front and rear side-door windows on the affected side of the vehicle to help protect outboard occupants from head injury and broken glass in certain side impacts or rollovers that exceed the deployment threshold.^a

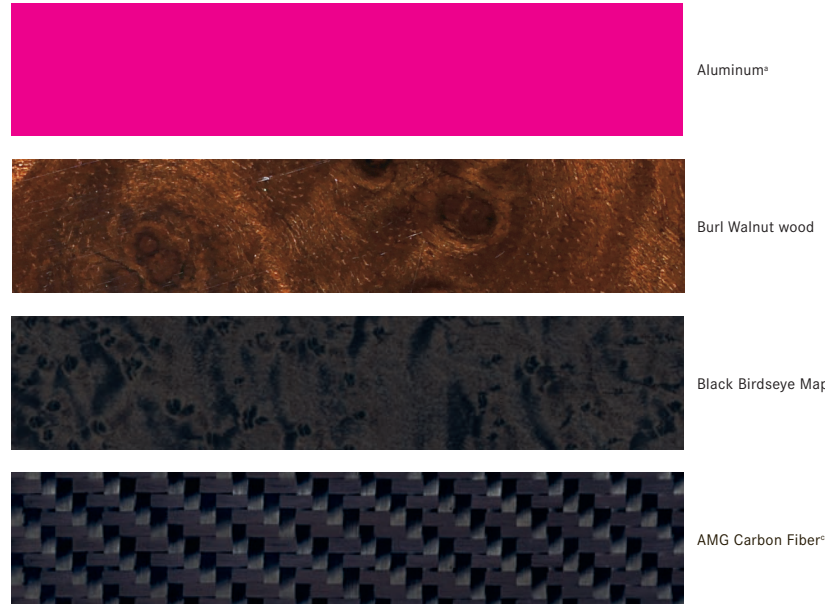

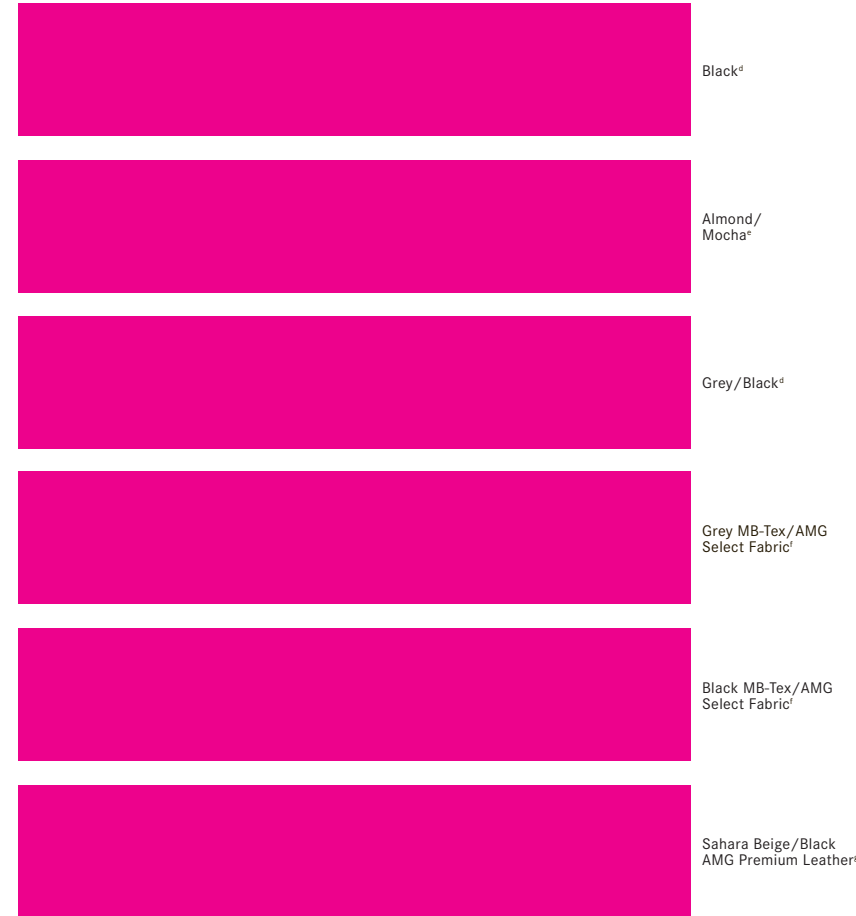

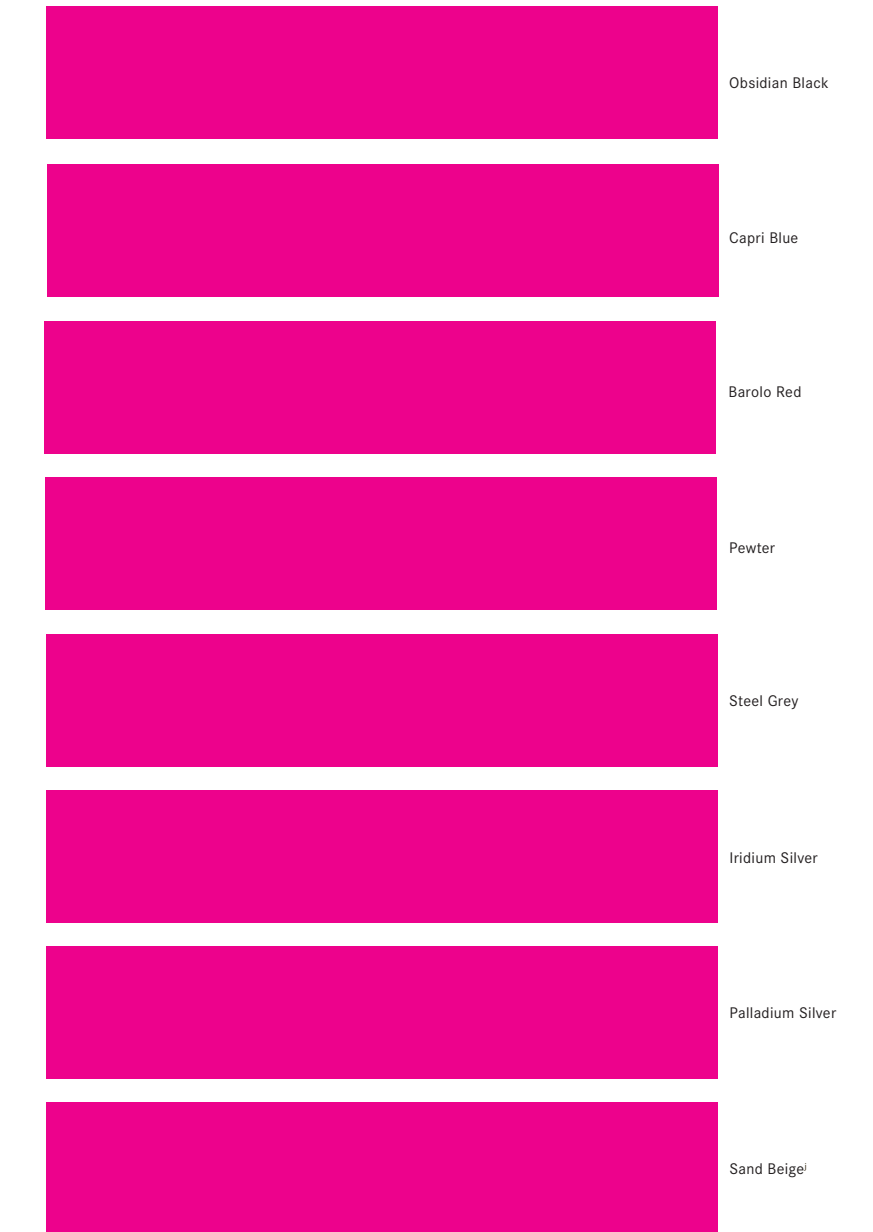
